

## June CFAC minutes

The Albemarle-ECBH CFAC met on June 13, 2010.

After the introductions and Comfort Agreement, the minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

For Gaps in Services Terry asked, "Now that we have picked up 10 counties do we have enough psychiatrists?" Mike said, "Dare County has the fewest." He also suggested that we look at the improved Web Site. Inez reported weaknesses in meeting needs of children with MI. Terry asked, "Where are we with SA and Detox centers?" Mike responded that there is 85% occupancy.

The Pitt LEG reported: Miss Annie broke her leg. Their program was on Child Drug Abuse and ways to build self esteem. The Craven LEG reported a program on Recreation Therapy by Melissa Lewis. The Beaufort LEG reported a program on DDSTART. To improve LEG attendance a recommendation to go quarterly was suggested and to hang announcements on church doorknobs.

Inez introduced Dalton Elks to the group.

A nominating committee was suggested for the up coming elections. Doris W. (Elizabeth G.), Terry Lathrop, Millie Hagler (Chair), Marvin Alligood. Mike offered to make conference calls or video conferencing available if needed.

Mike also reported that for SA that they are stabilizing and doing input studies to see about expansion and for MH the same. He recommended that we present written out recommendations to be presented to the Board. Four training needs were: 1. Medical waivers 2. CABHA's 3. CFAC & LME budgets 4. Planning sessions 5. Customer services
